

The Cellar Door

Our 400 year old threshing barn provides the perfect backdrop for year round licensed ceremonies. It comfortably accommodates up to 100 people seated and 200 standing. We have retained as much of the barn's heritage as possible, from the old beams and traditional red brickwork to the original arrow slits which we have framed to add to their character. To the rear there is a gorgeous rose-lined terrace and a lovely lawned garden, also licensed for ceremonies, where guests can relax. Underfloor ground source heating allows year round use whilst large glass windows on both sides of the barn let in as much daylight as possible, capturing beautiful sunsets across the back lawn during the evenings.

The Vineyard

Your open-air wedding ceremony can take place against the backdrop of our beautiful vineyard during the Summer months. Our bespoke cedar-wood gazebo stands proud at the top of our vineyard lawn and is the perfect place to exchange vows. After your ceremony, enjoy a glass of our award-winning sparkling wine and photographs in and amongst the vines before wandering across to the Cellar Door for your wedding breakfast and evening reception.

A 20% non-refundable booking deposit is required to secure any date. Your booking contract will include a payment schedule detailing further interim payments, plus final balance which is due 3 months prior to your wedding date. Full Terms & Conditions are included in your booking contract. All prices include VAT.







What time will our ceremony be and how do we book it?

Your ceremony time is your choice, subject to the availability of the regional registrars (Braintree). You will find their contact details in our Little Black Book and must confirm your booking with them direct. We recommend between 1 and 3pm depending on the activity you wish to schedule into your day. Our Weddings Manager can advise you.

What time does our evening party finish?

The last 'anthem' is played at 11pm and can be followed with background music or even a silent disco until the bar closes at 11:30pm. Carriages should be booked for 11:45pm to encourage all guests to be off site or in their accommodation by midnight. We strongly recommend taxis are prebooked due to our rural location.

How many can you seat at each table?

Our guest tables are 5'6" round and comfortably seat 8-10. Our top table is made up of trestles to create the desired length and can seat up to 10. Please note, all our tables require linens which your chosen Approved Caterer will include in their quote.

Do you allow street food?

We work closely with a number of self-contained street food suppliers who can cater for your evening guests. Alternatively, do discuss your evening requirements with your chosen Approved Caterer.

What do you do with the gallery space if you are not holding your ceremony up there?

From pamper stations and photobooths to cosy corners and gaming zones, the gallery is the perfect space to add some extra magic to your special day. Remember to consider whether older guests are comfortable taking the stairs or whether children would need to be supervised.

Do you allow bands and is there a sound limiter?

We welcome all bands inside the Cellar Door. Live music must finish at 9pm when your DJ can take over or your playlist can run via your own device. All performers / playlists must plug into our inhouse sound system in order to comply with our license. There is a sound limiter to monitor volume throughout but please rest assured this does not shut off the power or stop the party.

Do you allow foreworks, candles and frepits?

In line with our Insurance Policy, in order to protect the barn and its surroundings and out of respect for our neighbours, we do not permit the use of any naked flames or fireworks anywhere on site. We suggest battery operated candles, twinkling fairy lights and colourful smoke canons (outside use only) for those picture perfect moments.







Can I bring my dog?

We understand the importance of including your dog in your special day. Please ensure you have a designated person to take responsibility for your furry friend throughout the ceremony and to take them home once they have joined you for a few photos afterwards. Dogs are not allowed inside any of our onsite accommodation.

Can we use a drone?

Professional videographers only are permitted to use a drone. Full licensing documentation and insurance certificates must be supplied to us in advance.

Can we throw confetti?

In order to preserve our natural surroundings, we allow biodegradable confetti only.

Do you have an easel we can use for our table plan?

Yes, we can supply an easel for lightweight table plans no larger than A1. Please note, our easel is unable to support heavier items such as framed mirrors.

How many cars can park at the venue?

We have parking for up to 46 vehicles in our farm yard which is adjacent to the Vineyard and just a stone's throw from the Cellar Door. In line with our sustainability ethos, we actively encourage car sharing and taxis which must be prebooked. Vehicles can be left overnight at the owner's risk and must be collected the following day no later than 10am.

Is the venue accessible?

We have a lit pathway leading from the designated disabled parking area directly into Cellar Door which offers level access into the entire downstairs space including the bar and our accessible bathroom. Whilst our Vineyard is also level access, it is recommended that you consider the natural terrain and let us know if you or any of your quests might need assistance.

Does the venue have Wi-Fi?

We have free wi-fi throughout the Cellar Door and in The Farmhouse. Please be sure to follow us on Facebook and Instagram so you can tag us in your stories. Alternatively, please let us know if you would rather we didn't share log in details so your quests can live in the moment on your big day.
